Missionary focus of the Week Voice of the Martyrs Continuing to Pray for Our Persecuted Brothers & Sisters

Last Sunday was the International Day of Prayer for Persecuted Christians. Recently, the missions' committee sent a gift of \$2000, on behalf of the Elim family, to Voice of the Martyrs Canada. This money allows Voice of the Martyrs to provide packages containing practical items such as Bibles, books, clothing, food and household necessities to persecuted Christian families.

This year's focus is to distribute packages in North Africa, partnering with local churches in Morocco and Mauritania, and also to collaborate with Voice of the Martyrs Korea which will bless Christians in North Korea, China, Russia, Ukraine, Ethiopia, Eritrea and Laos.

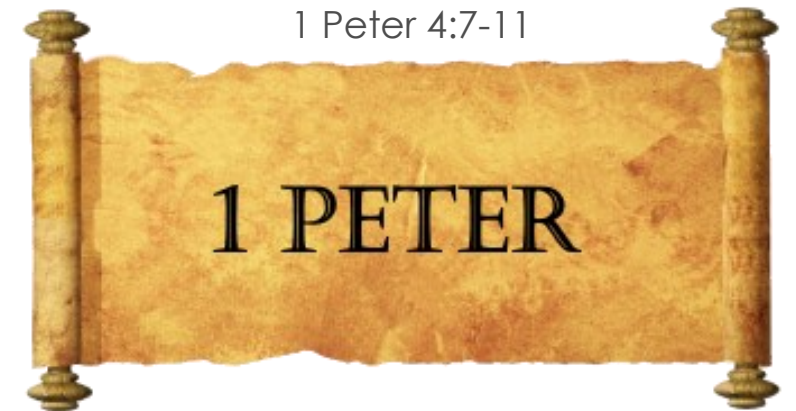
