Some of our teenage girls are currently participating in Healing Heart's "First Love" study, a unique three-part Bible study for young women. They are learning the big picture view of our need for salvation, how to love God with all their hearts as they address common sin struggles, as well as how to lay down their lives and live out God's love in their relationships.

Healing Hearts Bible studies have helped bring God's good news of hope to over 16,000 people worldwide who have been broken by sin. The studies reach life-long believers with unresolved issues, new believers seeking to reconcile their past with God's truth and unbelievers who are being introduced to the saving grace of the Gospel for the very first time. The study for men is "The Good Fight" and for women, "The Hem of His Garment". Check them out at healinghearts.org.

Kim Quinn is leading our young women in the "First Love" study and would be glad to give you more information about what other studies are available through Healing Hearts. 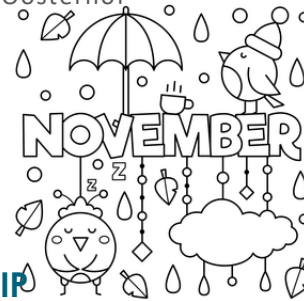
