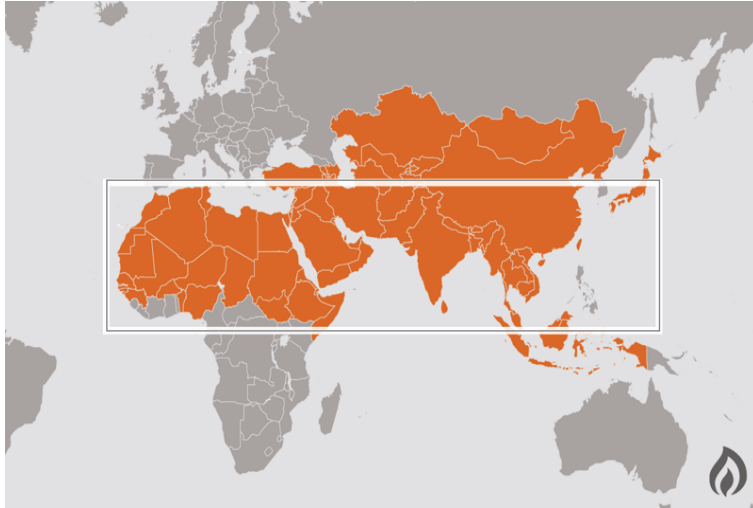


International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church (IDOP)

The International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church is observed on the first Sunday of November. Research suggests that more than 245 million Christians are persecuted.

"Persecuted Christians" refers to any person who is harassed or attacked simply because they identify as being a Christian. Examples of persecution faced by Christians include but is not limited to, physical attack, imprisonment, slavery, discrimination, and other forms of severe punishment.

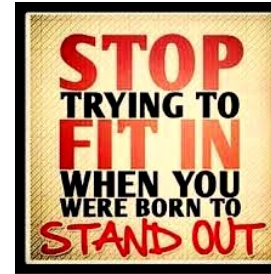

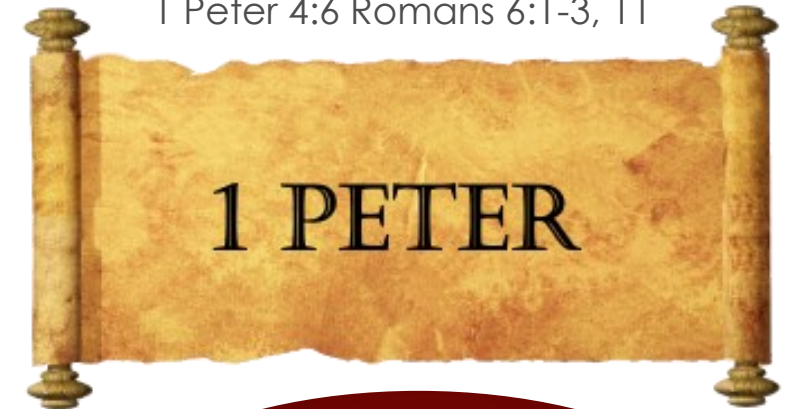

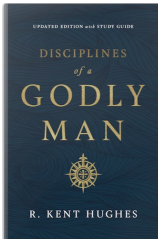

Book Review

What they meant for Evil by Rebecca Deng



This was an eye-opening and informative read-aloud for our family. It is the story of one of the first unaccompanied refugee children to enter the United States in 2000, after South Sudan's second civil war took the lives of most of her family. Rebecca's story begins in the late 1980s when, at the age of four, her village was attacked and she had to escape. With the candor and purity of a child, Rebecca recalls how she endured fleeing from gunfire, suffering through hunger and strength-sapping illnesses, dodging life-threatening predators-lions, snakes, crocodiles, and soldiers alike- and grappling with a war that stole her childhood. Her story is a lyrical, captivating portrait of a child hurled into wartime, and how through divine intervention, she came to America and found a new life full of joy, hope, and redemption.
