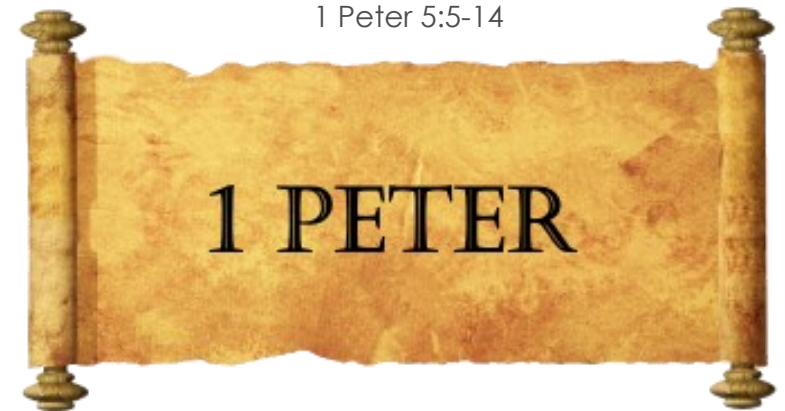

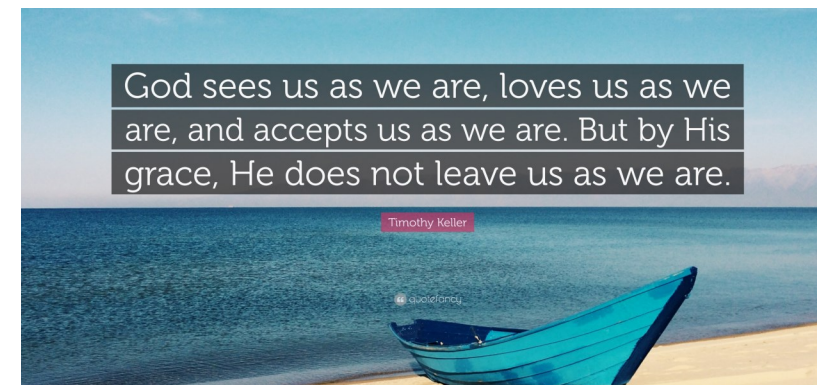

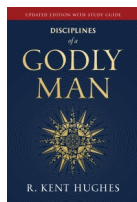
Women's Bible Study
