International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church Voice of the Martyrs

The founder of Voice of the Martyrs, Richard Wurmbrand, recognized that for Christians behind the Iron Curtain, true hope lay in their relationship with Jesus Christ rather than just escaping to the West. He believed that God's Word and the support of the faithful church provided them with enduring strength and solace in their struggles.

He urged Christians in the West to pray for imprisoned believers and support other followers of Jesus who were encountering various forms of persecution in their oppressive nations, emphasizing that our support should be rooted in love and prayer, even while knowing that it might lead to an increase of their persecution.

As members of Christ's body, we are called to regularly intercede on behalf of our suffering brothers and sisters – not only personally, but also corporately with fellow believers. November 3 has been designated as the International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church.
