Mission Focus

Our Persecuted Brothers and Sisters in DRC

Last Sunday morning, we were reminded of the horrific persecution our brothers and sisters are facing all over the world, when Blair told the story of 70 Christians found beheaded in a church in the Democratic Republic of Congo. The terrorists initially forced 20 believers out of their homes in the middle of the night. Later that day, 50 more were rounded up and all 70 were taken to a protestant church in Kasanga where they were brutally murdered.

Even though most of the DRC is Christian, there has been a significant increase in persecution over the past year. Pastors and Christian leaders are targeted and harassed for their faith; their families are also at risk. The DRC has no specific laws to protect Christian women and girls, making them vulnerable to domestic violence and forced marriages. Christian women are also at risk of abduction, rape, trafficking and sexual slavery. Christian men are at risk of being maimed, abducted, forced to join militia groups and killed. To escape, Christian men may be forced to pay large ransoms, driving their families deeper into poverty. Christian men also face workplace discrimination and may be denied jobs.

A local church leader was quoted as saying "We don't know what to do or how to pray; we've had enough of massacres. May God's will alone be done."

Open Doors and Voice of the Martyrs are two organizations that provide updates, and avenues to support the persecuted church. They have provided us with some ways to pray in this particular situation:

- Please prayerfully uphold all those in this targeted community who are mourning the tragic loss of their loved ones.
- Pray that God will guide the authorities as they deal with the guilty members of the ADF rebel group, whose intent is to establish an Islamic caliphate in this predominantly Christian nation.

In the midst of the upheaval, may the Lord minister the needed peace, protection and comfort to all citizens, especially those who have been traumatized by the attacks.
