Mission Focus

Our Compassion Children

Our Sunday school supports two children through Compassion: Abdiel, age 12, in Bolivia and Mariam 15 in Burkina Faso. Sponsorship costs are \$49 monthly plus \$100 at their birthdays and \$200 for the Christmas gift fund. Their letters, which often express gratitude for our support, also share a little of their interests and what their home life is like. Those letters are posted on the missions' board at the base of the stairs.

Compassion's motto: "Releasing children from poverty, in Jesus' name" is lived out in the centres where the children receive Christ-centred schooling, and provide access to healthcare, nutrition, safe water and hope! The support also allows their families a hand up to alleviate some of the financial difficulties they face.

As Mariam and Abdiel get older, they will be encouraged to start setting goals, and with Compassion's help, will put together plans for their futures. Life can be difficult in these countries, but with the help of sponsorship and the Compassion teams, our children have many advantages that they would not otherwise have.

Pray that Mariam and Abidel see their greatest need, the salvation that is offered through Jesus Christ, and that they would follow Him.

How can we be involved? We encourage you to engage with your Sunday-School-aged children to pray for Mariam and Abdiel. Letters, cards or notes could be given to Mary who will ensure they are delivered. Also, guide your children to contribute financially if they are able to use a portion of their savings, or part of the amounts they earn or receive; a great way to teach them the blessings of giving and sharing.
