The Ukrainian believers are reaching out to Ukrainians in crisis, most of whom are far from family members who are unable to leave Ukraine. Others are under a great deal of stress as they raise children on their own in Prague. There are also teenagers who have had to leave their parents and homeland and are trying to make sense of everything in a foreign country.

The believers in Prague know that their greatest need is to know and trust Jesus, and ask us to pray for compassion and courage for the Ukrainian believers as they depend on the lord to reach out to their countrymen who have escaped to Prague.

The newsletter also gives updates on Gretchen's English classes, some outreach to the people of Prague, a prayer request for the pastor of the Mongolian church that they work with and some other bits of news.

Mark and Gretchen are anticipating the arrival of their first grandchild, to be born to their daughter Naomi and her husband, in April. The happy occasion coincides with a previously-planned "home assignment." Mark & Gretchen will be leaving Prague on February 25 and splitting their time between home base in Windsor, Ontario and Minneapolis, Minnesota where Gretchen's family is, hoping to be in Ontario in April for the arrival of baby.

They signed off their latest newsletter with this: "Thank you for partnering with us as we labor for the Lord! May God bless you as you labor for him in your community" and often express their thanks for our financial support and our prayers.
