MISSION FOCUS

Pioneers

Arley McBlain

We recently received a letter from a fellow-worker of Arley's at Pioneers Canada (Fayek) thanking the Elim family for our monthly support of their ministry to reach Muslims across the Arab world with the life-changing message of the gospel.

He recounted that in 2026 they have already witnessed 70 individuals giving their lives to Christ through their media ministry and know of three new believers being baptised. The Pioneer team of digital responders has been able to interact with some 2300 people, having "impactful conversations". And he shares a message from a new convert who celebrates that he belongs to Christ, and that He is his rescuer and his Saviour.

Arley claims that his volunteer work supporting these missionaries in their work, is not as interesting as the stories that are coming out of the one-on-one contacts, but we know that the message could not be communicated without the technical expertise to create the websites that become the stepping stone to connect an unbeliever with a believer leading to the "real work" which happens face to face.

Arley describes his contribution as "humble work" – supporting the missionaries in their work. He provided a snapshot of some of what he is working on:

- Pioneers International: Building an Intranet (internal communication), and tech support
- Pioneers Canada: marketing materials, and website updates
- Pioneers Media: work on their Progressing Together online training app, and training Fayek's son how to make websites
- Various other Gateway websites (Australia, Peru, Dominican Republic, soon Brazil and Europe)

Pray for Arley as he balances his role at Pioneers with his career, and let's praise the Lord for the fruit that is coming out of the efforts of this amazing team of believers.

The righteousness we receive from God through faith is for God's glory, our blessing and is given apart from works.
