on Home Ministry Assignment in Ontario and Minnesota

Mark and Gretchen's monthly newsletter is posted on the missions' board downstairs. Their two-month furlough is divided between Gretchen's home church and family in Minnesota and their home base in Windsor Ontario. Three of their four grown children live in Windsor, while their oldest daughter, Noemi and her husband Moses are in Toronto, expecting the arrival of their first child (Mark & Gretchen's first grandchild) to be delivered by C-section yesterday (Saturday, April 4).

They write that they are thankful for opportunities to share what God is doing among the nations that have called the Czech Republic their home. They ask for prayer that they would communicate well as Mark speaks at some of their supporting churches, and that they would be an encouragement to people in Minnesota and Ontario to engage in prayer for the Czech Republic and for the world.

While away, Mark and Gretchen keep in close contact with the believers and leaders in Prague, and have good reports of those who have stepped up and stepped in, taking on leadership roles, to fill their shoes. They are actively passing the torch to the next generation of Czech leaders as they work towards retirement from in-person ministry in Prague in five years.
