⇒ Ontario Children's Aid Societies conduct more than **63,000** child protection investigations each year.

⇒ Across Canada, **61,100** children are currently living in out-of-home care.

Safe Families Sarnia-Lambton supports families in crisis as a preventative measure. Staff and volunteers provide practical help such as completing paperwork, building a budget, planning meals, getting to appointments and tutoring children. Leaning on their local churches, they surround families with caring, compassionate relationships.

Parents experiencing hardships like domestic violence, addiction recovery, or homelessness can temporarily place their children with vetted and trained Host Families while they work to stabilize their circumstances. Parents retain full custody throughout the process, and Safe Families staff walk alongside them as they make positive changes.

Elim's financial support provides Host Families from local churches with the items they need to welcome children into their homes. As our budget grows, we hope to hire an additional staff member as soon as possible.
