New Life Christian Academy

Punta Cana, Dominican Republic

Eugene and Karen Hartman have been invested in the Christian school in Punta Cana, which is overseen by Celebration Christian Church where they attend when in the DR. This past spring, Jonathan Autrey, the pastor of CCC, recognized the need for a second Christian school and led the local churches to launch its construction, at the existing church property in Veron. The New Life Christian Academy is slated to open in the fall of 2026 and expects to welcome up to 80 students and 14 full-time staff. Without the pre-designated financial backing of the first school, this has been a huge faith undertaking for the church and team, knowing each part of the progress will require the funding to be raised first, and yet still having the passion to open for this school year. They will continue with a sponsorship model for families that cannot afford the tuition to attend. Annual tuition and books cost about \$2,800 US per child. They have already raised support to give partial sponsorship to many enrolled families but still have 14 kids waiting for support to attend when the school opens.

Eugene and Karen have been working with the pastor to identify the opportunity for the next outreach trip opportunity. As we have previously shared, every year, Celebration Christian Church and sister Spanish congregations, partner to offer a Kings' Day Community tied to a traditional holiday remembering the visit of the magi after Christ's birth (Epiphany). Last year they had over 450 children and their families participate in a time of games, singing, dancing, food, and gifts, where the Gospel was proclaimed. Every year, the number of participants grows and the logistics for the event grow with them. There will be need for service including: transportation, set up, shopping and wrapping of gifts, preparing food and program, and leadership during the event. The timing of this year's event will be January 4 or 5, 2027, with opportunities to serve ahead of, and during the event day. The local church would welcome us to serve alongside them, as well as any donations to support this critical event in their church year. Teams would be welcome to also serve at Tabitha's closet or the school during the visit time as they felt led. If you are interested in joining a serve team, please connect with Eugene and Karen for more details.

- For Pastor Jonathan and his wife Jeanine: for wisdom, strength, and patience as they wait on the Lord for provision during a critical time in the school construction and lead the efforts forward. That they would be able to find a time of refreshment together, over the summer.
