After an urgent escape from the upheaval in Niger last November, Chuck and Sam have been living in the area, seeking the Lord's provision and guidance for the next stage of Chuck's ministry. The Sahel Academy in Niamey had to be shuttered with no expectation that it will commence operation in the foreseeable future.
