Over the last 70 years, Compassion revolutionized the fight against global poverty by partnering with local churches to meet the unique and urgent needs of children living in poverty. Mariam lives with her father, brother and sister in Ouagadougou where she is enrolled in the Rhema Child Development Centre. The centre provides biblical training, in addition to practical help for the children and their families. It does not appear as though she has any connection to a local church, however she reports that her favourite activities are Bible class and learning about the Lord.

Abdiel lives close to the city of Oruro which is located in the Andes mountains 12,000 feet above sea level. He is cared for by married parents, and has a sister who is also enrolled in the Compassion program. Abdiel is part of a local church with a Sunday school program and reports that his favourite activities are learning about God, and snack time! Abdiel is a competitive swimmer and is able to travel to other cities in Bolivia for meets.

While we pray specifically for the spiritual development and practical needs of our two children, let's also pray for the men and women making decisions and overseeing this international ministry, that their focus would remain on doing the work in Jesus' name.
