Robert & Susan Martin
serving the men incarcerated in the Kingston Penitentiary

Most of us have little connection with the men and women who are serving sentences in prisons. Even though we may not have easy opportunity to interact with these people face to face, we can pray.

Robert and Susan ask us to pray that their hearts would be opened to the Word of God and the message of the Gospel. They have seen several men put their faith in the Lord Jesus as their Saviour over the past few months and ask that we would pray for them as they learn to walk out their faith within the prison subculture.

They also asked us to pray for the men who are believers that are leaving prison to continue serving their sentence in halfway houses. They need fellowship with other Christians who will welcome and spiritually support them as they make this huge adjustment back into society. Pray that they will remain steadfast, growing in their faith.

They also ask for prayer for the chaplains as the government has begun cutting funding to the federal institutions causing some to lose their jobs, although Robert has not lost his access.
